On the basis of this Agreement by exchange of letters, Russian airlines may submit applications to operate public air services without restrictions to/from North Macedonia. These applications should be followed by necessary documentation as well as Designation.

The Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation presents its compliments to the aeronautical authorities of the Republic of North Macedonia and would like to address as follows.

Russian airlines express interest in operating flights to Skopje, however, in accordance with paragraph 1c of the Annex to the Air Services Agreement between the Government of the Russian Federation and the Government of the Republic of Macedonia dated March 22, 2001, "the frequency of flights ... of designated airlines will be agreed between the aeronautical authorities of the Parties."

In connection with the above, we propose to conduct an agreement by exchange of letters about the absence of frequency restrictions on all specified routes for the designated airlines of the Parties.

If you agree with the aforementioned proposal, we propose to consider this letter and a positive response to it as an agreement between the aeronautical authorities of Russia and North Macedonia on the abovementioned issue.

We hope to develop successful and mutually beneficial cooperation between our Authorities.
