Dear Mr. Jelinek,

The Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation presents its compliments to Civil Aviation Department of the Ministry of Transport of the Czech Republic and you personally.

Hereby I would like to confirm your letter Num. № 215/2018-220-LD/14 dated March 12, 2019 and the present letter form an agreement between the Aeronautical Authorities of the Russian Federation and the Czech Republic as follows:

1. To confirm that Russian air carriers can perform services from Zhukovsky airport as a regional point in the territory of Russian Federation on a permanent basis.
2. To provide Ural Airlines with the right to operate flights on the route Krasnodar – Prague v.v., until Yakutia Airlines is eligible to renew its own flights.
3. To increase the number of frequencies on the route Moscow – Prague v.v. up to fourteen (14) frequencies per week for the second designated air carrier of each side.
4. To increase the number of frequencies on the route St. Petersburg – Prague v.v. up to fourteen (14) frequencies per week in total for each Side.
5. To provide Czech Airlines with the permission to perform flights on the routes from the Czech Republic to the Russian Federation and v.v. with the exploitation of aircraft from its majority shareholder Smartwings a.s. on a permanent basis. The Russian air carriers will be granted a similar right to exploit aircraft of any

other Russian carriers while operating services from points in the Russian Federation to points on the territory of the Czech Republic.

Dear Ms. Petrova,

The Civil Aviation Department of the Ministry of Transport of the Czech Republic presents its compliments to the Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation as well as to you personally.

With reference to your letter ref. 9-312 dated 12 March 2019 I would like to appreciate your proposal aiming to find a compromise solution on further development of air services between our two countries. All four points are acceptable to our side provided that your side accepts Czech Airlines being able to perform its flights on the routes from the Czech Republic to the Russian Federation and v.v. with the use of aircraft from its majority shareholder Smartwings a.s. in order to achieve an improved efficiency of the utilization of the combined fleet of both air carriers.

Taking into account the above mentioned we propose to secure the following arrangement by exchanging of letters:

1. To confirm that Russian air carriers can perform services from Zhukovsky airport as a regional point in the territory of the Russian Federation on a permanent basis;
2. To provide Ural Airlines with the right to operate flights on the route Krasnodar – Prague and v.v., until Yakutia is eligible to renew its own flights;
3. To increase the number of frequencies on the route Moscow – Prague and v.v. up to fourteen (14) frequencies per week for the second designated air carrier of each side;
4. To increase the number of frequencies on the route St. Petersburg – Prague and v.v. up to fourteen (14) per week in total for each side;
5. To provide Czech Airlines with the permission to perform flights on the routes from the Czech Republic to the Russian Federation and v.v. with the use of aircraft from its majority shareholder Smartwings a.s. on permanent basis. The Aeronautical Authority of the Czech Republic will positively consider similar requests of the Russian air carriers in full reciprocity.

In the case of your agreement with the above mentioned proposal we suggest to consider the present letter and your affirmative reply to it as an arrangement between the Aeronautical Authorities of the Czech Republic and the Russian Federation on the above subjects.
